Good Hope Singers

Formed by the past students of Good Hope School Choir, Good Hope Singers has been registered as a charitable organisation since 2009. As its mission statement says,

"In Joy and Thanksgiving, we Sing to Serve Through Music, Love, Hope and Faith to Share"

The establishment of Good Hope Singers has made it possible not only for alumnae choristers of different generations to reunite on stage, but also to put forward what they had learnt in school by serving the community with their common love for music. To-date, it consists of over 300 members ranging from Hopers in the 1970s to fresh graduates in the 2020s.

Some of the concerts it hosted in the past include "Evergreen", the inaugural concert in 2010; "Seasons of Love" which celebrated its first anniversary and raised fund for the children in need at the same time; as well as "Love in Action", that was held twice in 2011 and 2015 respectively to raise funds for the relief of the Japan and Nepal earthquakes.

The Singers have experienced by themselves how singing brings a positive impact to one's life, therefore are determined to serve the community by, in particular, supporting the development of music education in Hong Kong. In 2012, it donated proceeds from its "My Rainbow" concert to a Music Therapy programme provided by the Heep Hong Society. Another example would be donating special music books to the visually-impaired children in Hong Kong Society for the Blind and Ebenezer School, with whom the Good Hope Singers performed collectively in the "Let Us Shine" concert in 2016.

Everything the organisation achieves today traces its roots back to the teachings from Good Hope School. In the spirit of thanksgiving, the Good Hope Singers Award was set up to support and encourage outstanding school choir members from the secondary and primary sections in their music education. Apart from that, Good Hope Singers maintains a close connection with its Alma Mater by participating in the annual New Year Concerts. It also actively collaborates with school choirs from the three sections to stage performances, such as the "Carolling Without Boundaries" virtual programme in 2020, and the "Shining Hopes of Christmas" concert in 2022.

This year, Good Hope Singers celebrates its 15th anniversary. The choristers look forward to continuing putting their musical gifts into good use, to make the world a better place.



Good Hope School Choir



Founded in 1959, Good Hope School Choir is one of Hong Kong's longestestablished and best choirs. Music choral training at Good Hope School aims at helping her choristers to become confident young women, enhancing their autonomous leadership, strengthening their sense of commitment to the school and society and nurturing a proactive learning environment to inculcate in its members a positive attitude to life and a readiness to reach their full potential.

The Choir has achieved outstanding results in various local and overseas music festivals. They won the championship in the Intermediate Girls - Foreign Language event and the Intermediate Mixed - Foreign Language and Chinese events in the 69th and 70th Hong Kong Schools Music Festivals, respectively. The Choir came first in the Intermediate Girls - Foreign Language and Junior Girls - Chinese categories in the 71st Hong Kong Schools Music Festival. This year, The Junior Girls - Foreign Language event won the championship in the 76th Hong Kong Schools Music Festival.

Their marvellous performances are not confined to Hong Kong, as many of their overseas tours have gained international acclaim. The Choir was the Gold Awardee of the 5th and 6th World Choir Games (2008 & 2010). In addition, they were the Gold Awardee in the Folklore category and Category Winner in the Children Choirs category of the 5th International Copernicus Choir Festival & Competition in Poland (2017). The Choir was crowned the champion of the 9th World Peace Choral Festival in Vienna (2018). In 2019, the choir was awarded the First Prize in Children's Category, Best Selected Competition Programme, and Grand Prix Varna at the 40th International May Choir Competition 2019 in Varna, Bulgaria. Also, they were the Category Winner of the Equal Voices – Junior and Sacred / Church Choir, Young Promising Pianist Award and Grand Prix Winner in the 12th International Choral Festival Orientale Concentus Singapore. Most recently, the Choir has won 3 Gold Awards and 3 category winners in the Bratislava Festival 2024. They were Children's Choirs up to 16 years, Musica Sacra with Instrumental Accompaniment, and Folksong with Instrumental Accompaniment. To broaden their experience, the young musicians have joined a rich array of cultural exchange tours to Beijing, Australia, Canada, Rome and Hungary.

The Choir has also been invited to perform on a number of different formal occasions, such as the Open Day at Government House, the Zonta International 17th District 17 Conference, the "Opening of the Legal Year" Mass and Christmas carolling. Good Hope School Choir will continue to bring exuberant joy to their audience through their sweet melodies.



Good Hope Primary School Choir

Good Hope Primary School Choir was established in 1980. The objectives of the choir are to foster music appreciation and develop musical talent. From 1999 to 2002, the choir participated in the "Singing Green" contest, where it won the Outstanding Performance Award and was the champion for three years. The choir also participates in the Hong Kong Schools Music Festival and achieves excellent results every year. It also participated in the "5th & 6th International Youth Music Festival" and won the Golden Award. Besides, the choir won the category winner and qualified for the Grand Prix of the 2017 Singapore International Choral Festival. In 2019, the choir was awarded the Category winner of the modern music, Gold award of the children choirs category, Grand prix finalist, The best presentation of the programme, The best performance of work by Yakov Dubravin (Russian song), Toe and composer for the piece and The best concertmaster of the competition in the "12th International Festival of Choral Art "Singing World" in Russia.

Apart from participating in different competitions, the choir has also helped its members to build up their social awareness. The choir has been involved in local charitable events, including the 2015 "Love in Action" concert for Nepal Earthquake Relief, raising funds for the disaster victims in Nepal. In 2016, some of the primary members joined the Secondary Choir to perform in "Canada Day". They have also performed in Cathedrals in Saint John, Montreal and Toronto. We hope students can share our school core values of "LOVE, HOPE, JOY and THANKSGIVING" with others through their singing.



Good Hope Kindergarten Choir



The Good Hope Primary School cum Kindergarten (Kindergarten Section) choir was established in 2010. It is made up of a group of adorable young girls. They spread the Good News with their angelic voices which impress everyone. They have participated in the Hong Kong Schools Music Festival for 9 years and have achieved excellent results such as the champion in Kindergarten Music Activities (Singing in English) and Grade A (Honours) in Children Vocal Solo.



Ms. Cindy Wong

Ms. Wong began her educational journey at Good Hope School, where she developed a passion for music from an early age. After graduating from secondary school, she pursued further studies at the Hong Kong Academy for Performing Arts, majoring in Voice.

From 2000 to 2008, Cindy served as a music teacher at Good Hope School, where she also took on the role of choir conductor. Under her baton, the choir achieved significant recognition and prizes, notably winning the Best Secondary School Girls' Choir at the Hong Kong Schools Music Festival in 2006.

With a strong foundation in both education and performance, Cindy continues to inspire students and foster a love for music in the community.

Ms. Jane Lau

Ms. Lau is a talented and accomplished choral conductor whose passion for music has flourished since childhood.

Throughout her primary and secondary education at Good Hope School, she was an active choir member. In her senior years, her remarkable abilities led to her selection as student conductor, garnering recognition when she received the Student Musician of the Year award from the South China Morning Post. Additionally, Jane was a member of the Hong Kong Children's Choir, where she delved into diverse genres of choral music and toured internationally.

Jane furthered her musical education by earning a Bachelor of Arts (Hons) in Music from the Chinese University of Hong Kong. She then obtained a Master of Arts in Music, specialising in choral conducting, from the Baptist University of Hong Kong, along with a Performer's Diploma in Pianoforte and Singing from the Trinity College of Music.

Jane started her career as the head of the music department at Belilios Public School (BPS), where she led the school choir to numerous awards at music festivals. Notably, the BPS choir was named Best Girls' Choir in 1997.


From 2007 to 2020, Jane led the music department at Marymount Secondary School (MSS), where the MSS choir achieved significant success in the Hong Kong Schools Music Festival. Under her leadership, the choir was crowned Champion in 2013, earning titles of The Best Girls' Choir of the Year and Most Outstanding Choir of the Year. They repeated this success in 2015, reclaiming the title of The Best Girls' Choir of the Year.

While at MSS, Jane led the choir to impressive success in several international competitions. In 2012, they travelled to Nyiregyhaza, Hungary, winning the Gold Award and the Best Kodaly Performance Award at the 9th Cantemus International Choral Festival, with Jane recognised as Best Conductor. The Choir continued to flourish worldwide and was awarded multiple prizes as they travelled to Russia in 2014, Hungary in 2016 and Italy in 2018.

Jane began her role as the conductor for the Hong Kong Medical Association Choir in 2023.

Ms. Melody Tang

Ms. Tang is a dedicated musician and educator. She showed remarkable musical talent from an early age.



Whilst studying at the HKAPA, Melody sang the role of Guadalena in La Perichole and Dorabella in Cosi Fan Tutte. After graduation, she appeared as soloist in various concerts, operas and musicals, such as Mysterium Misericordiae Concert: Mahler Symphony No.2 (2016) and the HKMA Orchestra Productions: Mendelssohn Lobgesang No.10 (2009) as well as participating in production projects, such as Vocal Recital - Voices for charity in Bangkok (2006) and Opera "Magic Flute" in Hong Kong and Beijing (2009).

Melody started her conducting and vocal coaching career with the Hong Kong Children's Choir in 2003. Since then, she has devoted herself to children's artistic development. She organised musical productions and training for children in the capacity of Music Director at the Hong Kong Children's Integrated Arts Center from 2005 to 2009.

Melody returned to her alma mater Good Hope School in 2010 and became the Music Director (Vocal) in 2012. She is keen on laying a solid foundation in music for students by providing them with choral training throughout their kindergarten, primary and secondary school life in Good Hope. Through music of different genres and various cultural exchange programmes with international choirs, the young musicians can broaden their scopes.

Under her leadership and coaching, the Good Hope School Choir has achieved excellent results in both local and overseas competitions. Owing to her outstanding performance as a choir conductor, Melody was awarded the Conductor's Prize at the 5th International Copernicus Choir Festival and Competition 2017 in Toruń, Poland, and a special prize for young conductor with the brightest presence at the 40th International May Choir Competition 2019 in Varna, Bulgaria.

Melody is committed to nurturing her choir members' confidence, leadership skills and readiness to reach their full potential.



Ms. Winnie Yip

During the days studying in Good Hope School, Ms. Yip began her conducting journey at a Music Camp when she was just in Form 4, where she participated in a workshop by Dr. John Nickson and was chosen to conduct a song in the New Year Concert. This experience sparked her passion for conducting in choral music. She later served as a student conductor for the school's Junior Choir, leading them to numerous awards at the Hong Kong Schools Music Festival. Winnie has also conducted the Good Hope School Choir at various events, including the Canadian Music Tour, Millennium celebrations, and different inter-school concerts.

Winnie's passion for music has not diminished over the years. She continues to use her professional expertise and dedication to music to contribute to the betterment of her Alma Mater, by serving as the treasurer of Good Hope Singers' executive committee, and by coordinating its choir rehearsals.

Soprano Soloists



Ms. Lorraine Chan

Ms. Chan is currently a final year student at the Hong Kong Academy for Performing Arts. She is studying for her Bachelor of Music (Hons) majoring in Voice, under the tutelage of renowned Soprano Prof. Nancy Yuen. Before her Bachelor's degree, she was a student of Soprano Jovita Leung. Following her graduation from Good Hope School as a choir member, Lorraine continues to be actively involved in a wide range of productions ranging from choral performances to opera.

Lorraine has received the Trinity LTCL Vocal Performance Diploma and the Trinity ATCL Violin Performance Diploma. She is also an awardee of the HKSAR Government Scholarships for Outstanding Performance, the Hong Kong Children's Choir Scholarship and the Hong Kong Outstanding Teens Election. She was one of the finalists chosen to attend the Asia Music Competition For Young Artist Busan 2019, and was awarded with Distinction.

Lorraine had appeared in operas and opera scenes as Susanna in Le Nozze di Figaro, Cunegonde in Candide, Pamina in Die Zauberflöte and Tytania in A Midsummer Night's Dream.

Soprano Soloists



Ms. Tammy Shum

Ms. Shum holds a Master of Music in Voice and Opera Performance from the Schulich School of Music at McGill University, where she studied under the tutelage of soprano Aline Kutan. She is recently awarded the Li Ka Shing Foundation & Opera Hong Kong Young Artist Overseas Fellowship for her outstanding vocal artistry. She graduated from the Chinese University of Hong Kong with a Bachelor's Degree in Music with First Class Honours in 2022, and was awarded the HKSAR Talent Development Scholarship (Performing Arts) and the Hong Kong Children's Choir Music Scholarship for her academic excellence. She was also awarded the Lee Bing Memorial Scholarship for Voice Majors offered by CUHK in support of her postgraduate studies. During her studies at Good Hope School, she was a choir member and was awarded the Good Hope Singers Scholarship, Tuition Scholarship for Choir Members and Academic Excellence Award in Music for consecutive years.

As a passionate young soprano, Tammy has appeared as Susanna from Mozart's Le Nozze di Figaro, and Papagena from Mozart's Die Zauberflöte. She has also appeared as a soprano soloist with the Chung Chi Choir and the Schulich Singers, performing repertoire ranging from Beethoven's Choral Fantasy and Camille Saint-Saëns' Oratorio de Noël. Her professional engagements include being a member of the Opera Hong Kong Chorus and Musica Viva (Hong Kong) Opera Chorus.

Tammy is currently based in Hong Kong as an active performer and music educator.



Ms. Eslie Chow

Ms. Chow started playing the piano since the age of 3, as well as percussion under the tutorship of renowned percussionist Ms. Choi Suk Fan. Her musical talents enabled her to become both the pianist of the school choir and leader of the symphonic band, during her secondary school years in Good Hope School.

With her piano accompaniment, the choir was awarded the Gold Medal at the 2010 World Choir Games in Shaoxing. Eslie also served as the accompanist for the choirs, ensembles, voice duet and solo participants at the Hong Kong Schools Music Festival, and had joined multiple music tours with the school choir, including to Shanghai, Shaoxing, Canberra and Sydney.

The heavy workload as a pianist did not stop Eslie from playing the percussion at the same time. She participated in the Hong Kong Schools Music Festival and Hong Kong Youth Music Interflows with the school symphonic band. For her dedication to musical teamwork, she was awarded the Music Scholarship from Good Hope School and the Sir Robert Black Trust Fund - Grants for Talented Students in Non-academic Fields.

Eslie currently works in a different industry, but remains to be a passionate pianist and percussionist. She is actively involved in musical activities, such as performing with the Good Hope School Alumni Symphonic Band, the Hong Kong Chamber Orchestra, the Parsons Wind Orchestra, the Psalm Wind Orchestra, the Hong Kong Festival Wind Orchestra as a percussionist, as well as playing the piano for and singing in the Good Hope Singers.



Ms. Esther Yip

Ms. Yip initially joined the choir as the sole pianist. Through dedicated daily practice sessions with various groups, she honed her craft. Her talent was recognised when she was singled out by the adjudicator in the music festival for her remarkable performance. Even after graduating, Esther remains deeply engaged with the choir, consistently contributing her skills and passion to the musical community.



Ms. Iris Lau

Hong Kong young pianist Ms. Lau holds a Master's Degree in Music Studies (Performance) from the Sydney Conservatorium of Music. Winner of multiple prizes and scholarships, Iris has studied piano since the age of 3 and won her first piano award in the Asian Youth Music Competition at the age of 5. Her nine-year experience as the school choir pianist of Good Hope has played a significant role in further extending her talent in music and piano performance. Upon graduating from Good Hope School as the recipient of the Music Tuition Scholarship and the Academic Excellence Award in Music for three consecutive years, Iris pursued her Bachelor of Music (Honours) Degree at the Hong Kong Academy for Performing Arts under the tutelage of Dr. Amy Sze. As a testimony to her efforts and growth, she was then granted the Molly McAulay Memorial Scholarship and the Chapple Bremner Scholarship which fully supported the tuition and living expenses of her Postgraduate studies in Sydney, Australia. On top of numerous solo performance experiences guided by Prof. Daniel Herscovitch, Iris also participated in several Masterclasses by Edward Auer, Katarzyna Popowa-Zydroń, Rita Reichman, Glenn Riddle, etc.

Iris is currently based in Hong Kong as an active solo performer, chamber musician and educator.



Ms. Jennifer Chan

Ms. Chan is a fresh graduate from Good Hope School in 2022. She had been serving as a piano accompanist for the school choir since primary school, and that continued as she entered the secondary section. With her accompaniment, the choir performed excellently both locally at the Hong Kong Schools Music Festivals, and globally at numerous international choral festivals. Although Jennifer has already completed her secondary education, she still has a lot of passion for music and is hoping to participate in more Good Hope Singers events in the future.



Ms. Rachel Yu

Ms. Yu is currently in her third year of undergraduate studies in Music at The Chinese University of Hong Kong, majoring in Piano, under the tutelage of Dr. Cheng Wai, Vivian. She also studied piano under Miss Ada Hau before entering the university and received piano coaching from Ms. Julie Kuok and Prof. Polina Fedotova. In addition, she is minoring in Voice under the tutelage of Ms. Margaret Yim.

As an enthusiastic pianist, Rachel attained the Associate of Trinity College London in 2021. During her years in Good Hope School, she has performed with both the school's girls choir and mixed voice choir (in collaboration with St. Paul's College) as a piano accompanist, in events such as Our Dream 2016 and Legal Year Opening Ceremonies. She has also been performing as the choir's pianist overseas, including Rome, Poland, Vienna, and Macau, and as a chorister locally in Ponte Orchestra & Singers, and in the 2021 Hong Kong Hymnos Festival.

At CUHK, Rachel has been playing as the ensembles' pianist, including the Chung Chi Choir. She has performed on various occasions, such as the Steinway & Sons Chamber Concert, the French Music Project at CUHK 2023, and at the piano production factory of Parsons Music Corporation in Yichang.

Rachel has participated in a wide range of competitions, including the Hong Kong Schools Music Festival's piano solo and duet categories, as well as in the choir division as a pianist and chorister. She has also been awarded third place in the 10th HK Students Open Music Competition, and Champion of IYACC The 4th International Open Piano Competition.

Violinists



Ms. Carole Lee

Ms. Lee started her violin studies at the age of eight, under the tutelage of Mr. Wong Wai Ming and Mr. Lung Heung Fai. She has obtained LTCL Diploma in Violin Performance (distinction) from Trinity College London, and is a Music Degree holder of Hong Kong Baptist University, majoring in Violin.

With her great passion for performing, Carole and her friends formed the HKCE String Quartet, which debuted at St. John's Cathedral in 2015. Carole is also a member of the Hong Kong String Orchestra and the Pan Asia Symphony Orchestra. In 2016, she performed with the Pan Asia Symphony Orchestra at its 40th anniversary concert in Beijing Concert Hall.

With herself being an alumnae of Good Hope School, Carole now teaches violin classes in Good Hope Primary School cum Kindergarten (Primary Section), as well as other schools and organisations such as St Stephen's College.

Violinists



Miss Tanya To

Miss To is currently in Form 5 and has been active in the choir not only as a chorister, but also as a pianist and violinist. She played the violin and piano for several choir events, such as the choir musical and Christmas carolling. She has been granted the choir scholarship for five consecutive years and received the Martin Tai Memorial Award. Tanya has obtained the LTCL diploma in violin performance from Trinity College London. Additionally, she has served as the concertmaster of the Hong Kong Children's Symphony Orchestra and was even selected to collaborate with the Hong Kong Sinfonietta in the world premiere of the musical "Alice in Wonderland".

Programme Notes

To tell the story of a 65-year-old choir in two hours is a real challenge. The organising committee has dug out and flipped through their old, heavy music scores, interviewed choristers of different generations, listened to some historic archived recordings - finally decided on this repertoire - hoping to show how Good Hope School Choir has made a golden way through its several eras.

Soon after Good Hope School was founded in the late 1950s, Sr. Regina Beliveau MIC, the music teacher at that time, established a choir primarily to provide music for the school's daily offices and celebrations, such as assemblies and masses. Fast forward to the mid-1970s, when Mrs. Daisy Tai (whom we fondly refer as Ms. Yung) and Mrs. Betty Tham took over, the choir was already performing so well that it triumphed at multiple events at the Hong Kong Schools Music Festival.

According to the past students, 海濱之歌 (The Strand) was a song so loved by Ms. Yung that they used to sing very frequently, second only to the school song. The choral piece rearranged based on a popular Japanese folk song talks about the mixed emotions of reminiscing the past and our loved ones who have left us. Tonight, the Good Hope Singers shall bring this piece onto the stage again to honour Ms. Yung's memory.

Speaking of songs that were often sung, here comes 輕笑 (Soft Giggles), 你的夢 (Your Dream), and The Snow, the pieces commonly used to compete in Music Festivals from the 1990s to early 2000s. With them, the choir has won prestigious titles like "The Best Secondary School Girls Choir" and "The Most Outstanding Secondary School Choir of the Year", under the leadership of the two abovementioned choirmasters as well as Ms. Cindy Wong.





The 2010s saw the Good Hope family grow bigger and bigger, as the kindergarten section was reopened. Since then, a close bonding across choirs of the three sections has been fostered, credits to Ms. Melody Tang who became the school's vocal music director. In tonight's programme, Good Hope Singers will collaborate with the three sections respectively to present 無憂 (Carefree), Love in Any Language, and Over the Rainbow. 無憂 is a Cantonese Acapella piece written especially for the secondary junior choir in 2019. It was performed so beautifully by the girls that awarded them championship. While the first song is about the joy of singing, the latter two echo the other core values of Good Hope - love and hope. Finally, all the choirs from the four generations will jointly stage 歲月如歌 (A Timeless Tune), another piece of composition dedicated to the Good Hope School Choir in recent years.

Tonight's concert, "Anchorus", is indeed a precious and meaningful occasion where Good Hope's choristers, conductors, sopranos, pianists, and accompanists can all pull together for one aim. Some of them have already become professional musicians, others excel in different areas, but it's the sweet memories that we hold in common that comfort us even when we follow different life paths. This is why we chose *Omnia Sol* to be our opening performance, representing how warmth and light have stayed in our hearts despite the passage of time and people. *And Music Will Lead Us*, even when tonight's concert will finally come to an end.

As the saying goes, a minute on stage takes a decade of practice. We hope you will enjoy our two-hour performance, behind which is 65 years of a jubilant journey.
